

Engineering is not skill to produce products and construct infrastructure



from viewpoints of people who live there




7 Oversea Bases of GCOE Project






Cause of Natural Disasters

Natural/Man-made Disaster along River Basin in Asian Countries




Collaborative Education Program in 2013







DRC Alliance universities at present


