- 08:43 RTE posted situation summary
- 11:07 RTE posted situation summary
- 12:30 RTE took Thai students from Kumamoto University
- 12:41 TSAJ opened new emergency email address
- 13:10 RTE posted **TV news** on evacuation of Thai citizens at Yufuin
- 14:04 RTE posted that 87 Thai were evacuated by bus from Beppu Arena to Fukuoka Airport

### April 17, 2016 (Sun)

- 15:55 Evacuees arrived **Global Arena**, Fukuoka
- 16:30 Evacuees arrived their decided destinations (e.g., Fukuoka Airport, Fukuoka City)
- 17:10 Evacuees from Kumamoto arrived destinations (e.g., Fukuoka Airport, Global Arena)
- 17:54 RTE shared Kumamoto Airport and Shinkansen situation
- 18:23 Evacuees from Yufuin arrived destinations

### April 19, 2016 (Tue)

 12:03 RTE helped evacuating the last Thai group from shelter to their destination in Fukuoka

### **Hotlines & Emergency email**

- RTE: Received 200 cases via hotlines
  - 30-40% tourists
  - 60-70% students
- **TSAJ**: Received **2 cases** via emergency email
  - 100% students

### **Lessons Learned**

- Database of citizens staying/visiting overseas
- Evacuation plan
- Multi-channel communication
  - Telephone
  - email
  - Website
  - SNS







# Suggestion to Thai People staying/visiting Japan

- Register your information at the Royal Thai Embassy Tokyo's site: http://site.thaiembassy.jp/th
- Study instruction on safety confirmation
  - Mobile app/Disaster Message Board
- Check the nearest evacuation shelter
- Check free Wi-Fi spots
  - Ex. "7SPOT", "LAWSONFreeWi-Fi", "Famima\_Wi-Fi"
- Prepare emergency bag and necessary things

## **Future Works**

- Phase 1b (2017): Comparison with the 2011 Great East Japan earthquake
- Phase 2 (2017-2018): Focusing on evacuation of Indonesian/Malaysian during the 2016 Kumamoto Earthquakes
- Phase 3 (2018): Focusing of community disaster education and disaster drills in Thailand, Indonesia, Malaysia
